Complications of worms are not just related to gut!

What starts as a harmless infection can quickly escalate to severe damages, leaving your pet vulnerable to serious health risks



 Nutritional Deficiencies:
Worms steal the nutrients from pet's food, leading to weakness and poor growth

2. Anemia:

Hookworms attach to intestine and suck blood, leading to significant blood loss.






3. Digestive Issues:

Worms irritate intestinal lining, causing vomiting, diarrhea and bloating.

4. Constipation:

A heavy worm burden can block the intestines, leading to constipation and severe discomfort.





Tissue Damage:

Worms can cause tissue damage by directly feeding on or invading organs.
